Caution Information

French Creek headwaters are fairly narrow and are susceptible to downed trees (strainers) that are a potentially serious threat and can change year to year. Several riffles are identified on the map that can be navigated with minimal paddling experience. Avoid the upstream side of bridge abutments. Scout ahead at the breached low-head dam near Saegertown which can be run or portaged on river left.
